#### Dimensions

You will find the dimensions of your printed matter in our signature layout or our quotation.

## Logos, subtexts and slogans

- EPS vector file
- · AI Adobe Illustrator file

Always texts converted into contours.

Lines and line thicknesses converted to contours.

## Print work on Forex / Perspex / self adhesive / cloths for frame system (tendon cloth)

## Deliver as:

- PDF
- Scale 1 to 1, with a resolution of 150 dpi, without bleed and without crop marks.

## Cloth / flagcloth / Airtexcloth

#### Deliver as:

- PDF
- · Scale 1 to 1, with a resolution of 150 dpi, with 10 cm bleed all around and without crop marks.

Prints larger than 500 cm: scale 10%, indicate this in the file name! Pay attention! Then the resolution must be 1500 dpi.

## Pantone / PMS

Specify your Pantone corporate identity color(s) separately. We use your Pantone colors as a reference for other materials such as paint, foil and printed matter. Please note that Pantone colors can only be as close as possible due to different materials and inks.
